The credit accounts and loans were procured through Stonewood Consulting, a company that is presently under investigation by the Riverside County District Attorney and the Federal Bureau of Investigation. Affiant has not received any benefit or value, in any meaningful sense. The Stonewood Consulting - related parties took all proceeds received through the transaction(s) and failed to provide documents as to what was done with the money.**

Affiant will testify, declare, depose or certify to the truth of any or all of the foregoing before any competent tribunal, officer, or person in any legal proceedings, civil or criminal, which is now pending or which may hereafter be institute in connection with the matter contained in this affidavit. All or substantially all of the facts alleged in Superior Court of California, in and for the County of Riverside, Case No. 463483 are true to my knowledge.**
- 3. Affiant fully realizes that any affected lender, by reliance on information contained herein, may ultimately cause the arrest of a person or persons responsible for alleged fraud involved in the procurement of any loan or credit line encompassed in Exhibit "1" and affiant will hold harmless any such lender from any action brought by any such persons following any unlawful arrest or prosecution by any criminal agency.**
